AVIATION EXTERNAL FIREFIGHTING COURSE

COURSE OUTCOMES

Students will experience a fully interactive 1 day training session that explores external aviation fires with multiple scenarios.

STUDENT GROUP

This course is aimed primarily at personnel in the role of a Firefighter within the aviation industry but is open to all local authority fire services and industrial fire services.

PRE ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

Due to the physical nature of this course, students are required to demonstrate prior to attendance that they have been medically assessed and deemed fit and able to undertake course activities. All personnel must be fully competent in the use of breathing apparatus.

Accommodation can be arranged if required.

PPE can be supplied if required.

COURSE CONTENT

At the completion of the course students will have knowledge of:

- Deployment and positioning of firefighting appliances at incidents
- Initial firefighting considerations
- Correct use of monitors
- Correct use of sidelines and hose reels
- Complementary media.

AIM

To ensure that students are competent in the use of firefighting techniques to safely extinguish external aviation fire scenarios. Students attending this course will receive training in FF Role map Unit:

- AFF 3 Extinguish fire at aircraft incidents
- AFF4 Save and preserve endangered life at incidents.

ASSESSMENT

Students are continually assessed throughout the course.
