# AVIATION INCIDENT SCENE MANAGEMENT COURSE (AISM)

---

## COURSE OUTCOME

---

At the end of this course students will have a greater understanding of the risks associated with fires and incidents involving aircraft. They will also be able to practise tactics and techniques in dealing with a simulated aircraft fire.

## COURSE AIMS

---

To provide technical and practical training in order to understand the requirements within Aviation Fire Service Policies and Procedures and demonstrate appropriate practical competency in applying these procedures at simulated aircraft incidents.

## COURSE OBJECTIVES

---

At the end of the course students will be able to:

- Describe the various materials used in aircraft construction and how they will react in a fire situation including fuel and fuel tanks
- State the appropriate tactics and techniques used when dealing with aircraft accidents/incidents
- Describe the hazards present at an aircraft accident/incident and the potential risks for crews and casualties
- Describe the requirements for preserving the scene at an aircraft accident/incident
- State the principles of Incident Command at an aviation incident and the requirements for aerodrome rendezvous points

## COURSE DURATION

---

Two days non-residential. Accommodation can be arranged if required at extra cost.

## STUDENT NUMBERS

---

The AISM course normally aims to run with up to ten students. This can be increased by special request.
