BREATHING APPARATUS INSTRUCTOR COURSE (BAI)

COURSE OUTCOMES

On the successful completion of the course students will be able to:

- Demonstrate a high level of knowledge of the required guidance and legislation as applicable to breathing apparatus
- Plan, prepare, supervise, and conduct practical and theory-based exercises including effective debrief techniques
- Understand and implement safe systems of work for breathing apparatus training exercises

Each student will have an end of course individual development feedback report.

COURSE AIMS

To ensure the students are able to devise and deliver training on the technical aspects and operational use of breathing apparatus, competently.

ASSESSMENTS

The attributes essential for a breathing apparatus instructor are continually assessed throughout the course. In addition, a written test is given to determine the underpinning knowledge in the technical areas and procedures. The students are also assessed during their syndicate/practical exercises.

COURSE DURATION

Two weeks. Accommodation can be arranged if required.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Due to the physical nature of this course, students are required to demonstrate prior to attendance that they have been medically assessed and deemed fit and able to undertake course activities.
