INCIDENT COMMAND

COURSE OUTCOMES

At the end of this course the student will have a greater understanding of the incident command system and how this fits into an aviation incident. They will also have the opportunity to practise these skills using our XVR system with bespoke built scenarios. This course is classroom-based using VR (Virtual Reality).

COURSE AIMS

To provide technical and VR training in order to understand the requirements within the Aviation Fire Service in relation to Incident Command. And to demonstrate appropriate competency in applying these skills at simulated VR incidents.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the end of the course students will be able to:

- Understand the principles of risk management
- Understand the application of a tactical mode
- Develop a tactical plan
- Continuously review information and adjust plans to meet changing needs of incidents
- Conduct a comprehensive handover briefing with the L2 incident commander.
- Undertake sector command role at a level 2 incident
- Conduct a hot debrief with crews
- Assessments by VR

COURSE DURATION

Initial - Two-day non-residential (lunch included). Accommodation can be arranged if required at extra cost.

Refresher - One-day.
